

Tipple Trip Clevedon - (White Hart) - Portishead - Sheepway - (The Priory) - Clapton - (Black Horse) - Nortons Wood Lane - (Old Inn) - Clevedon (14.5 miles.)



From Clevedon Library to the Triangle and along Old Street. At the second mini roundabout go left past the Old Inn. Follow this road through Walton and then Weston (and the White Hart) into Portishead, past Gordano School. Go right at the mini roundabout and follow the road until it meets major roundabout at the A369. Go straight ahead onto Sheepway. Before you meet the dual carriageway go left over the footbridge into Portbury village. (The Priory). Go right after the pub along Caswell Lane. (For the adventurous take a detour up Caswell Hill (quite arduous) by going left after the Rugby Club then right at the top, down Naish Hill and rejoin the route) For the rest carry on along the road under the motorway bridge until you reach Naish Hill. Go right down the hill and then second left into Clevedon Lane. (The Black Horse is about a quarter of a mile along here on the Right). Might as well stop. You've earned it. Carry on. St Michael's Church about 1.5 miles along is worth a stop though no beer. On through Norton's Wood Lane and back to Clevedon. Refreshments again available in the Old Inn. No requirement to stop in every pub unless it's a very hot day.
